Why do we need your support?

Rays of Sunshine brightens the lives of seriously and terminally ill children aged between 3 and 18 years old and their families across the UK.

Our work includes:

Granting wishes, which can be as unique as the children themselves – from being a princess or a fireman for the day to a trip to Disneyland

Working with children's hospitals and hospices to host activity days and grant Hospital Ward Wishes (e.g. installing play areas and sensory rooms)

Jo will also feedback on any support we receive as a direct result of your research
