#### What's in it for you:

#### Main Tasks:

- Capture candid and engaging photos of event participants, volunteers, and key moments throughout the event. This could include portraits, action shots, and context imagery.
- Focus on capturing the spirit and emotion of the event, highlighting the joy, hope, and magic on display.
- Be adaptable and flexible to changing situations and shooting scenarios, including working with different lighting conditions and potentially large crowds.
- Follow event guidelines and instructions regarding photo permissions, prohibited areas, and specific shots requested by the organizers.
- Post-process selected photos according to provided specifications, ensuring high quality and appropriate editing for online and print use.
- Collaborate with event organizers on photo selection and potential future use of images.

## Desired knowledge, skills and experience:

While previous experience is beneficial, Rays of Sunshine welcomes passionate individuals with the desire to learn and contribute. We can provide training and support to help volunteers hone their skills and become valuable members of the team.

- Passion for Rays of Sunshine's work and a good knowledge of the services we offer
- Be outgoing and personable
- Strong photography skills and creative vision: Ability to compose compelling shots, utilise lighting effectively, and adapt to different settings.
- Working knowledge of digital photography equipment: Familiarity with DSLR or mirrorless cameras, basic lens knowledge, and understanding of camera settings.
- Basic post-processing skills: Ability to edit photos for colour correction, exposure adjustments, and minor cropping.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills: Ability to work effectively with event organisers, volunteers, and participants, and follow instructions clearly.
- Discretion and respect for privacy: Understanding of consent protocols and ensuring responsible use of captured images.

### **Training and Support**

The following training and support will be given:

- Safeguarding: Mandatory training on child protection policies and procedures, recognising abuse, and reporting concerns.
- Confidentiality: Importance of keeping personal information confidential, especially regarding beneficiaries and their families.
- Data protection: Understanding and adhering to data protection regulations when capturing and storing photos.

Training will be delivered by online modules that flexible and accessible for self-paced learning.
