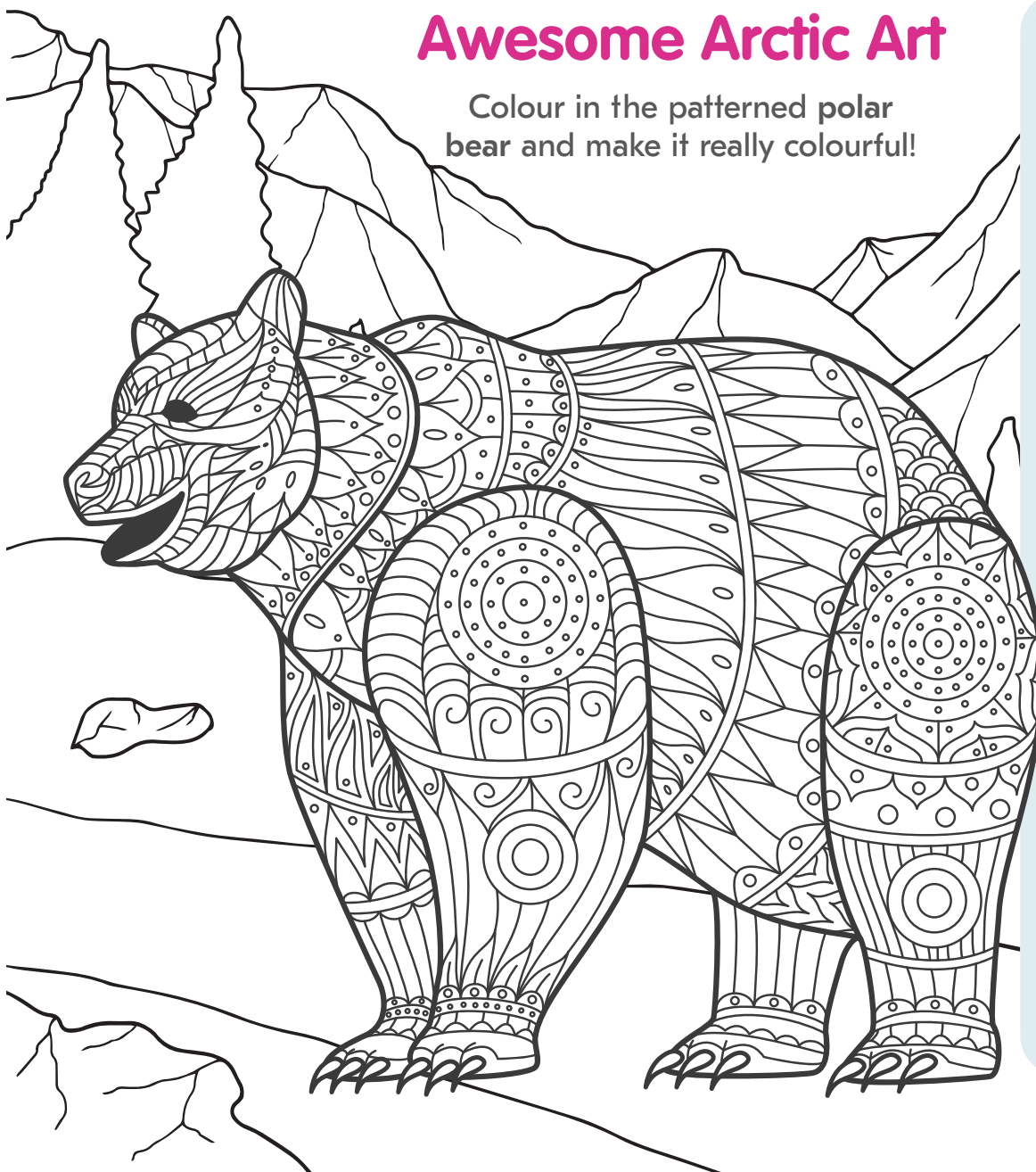

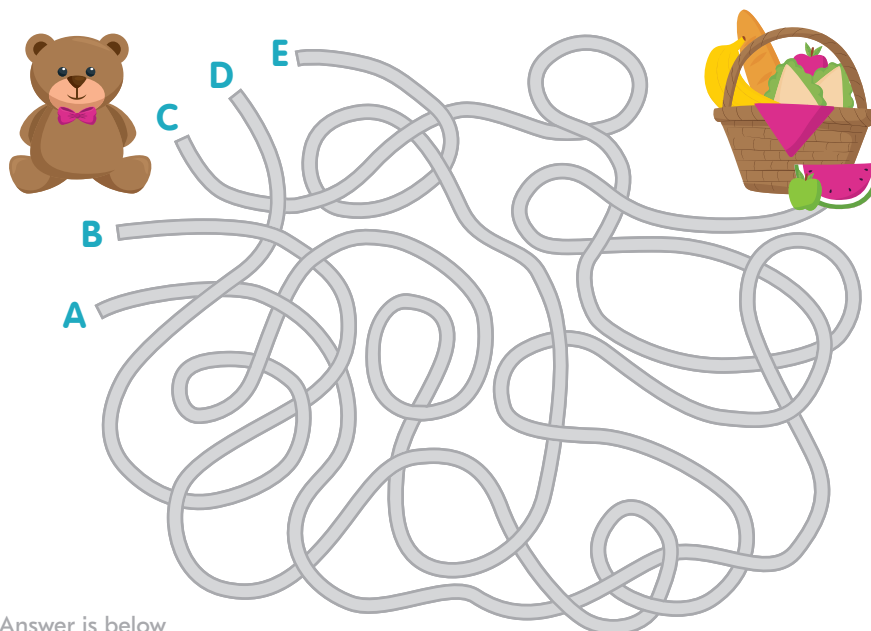

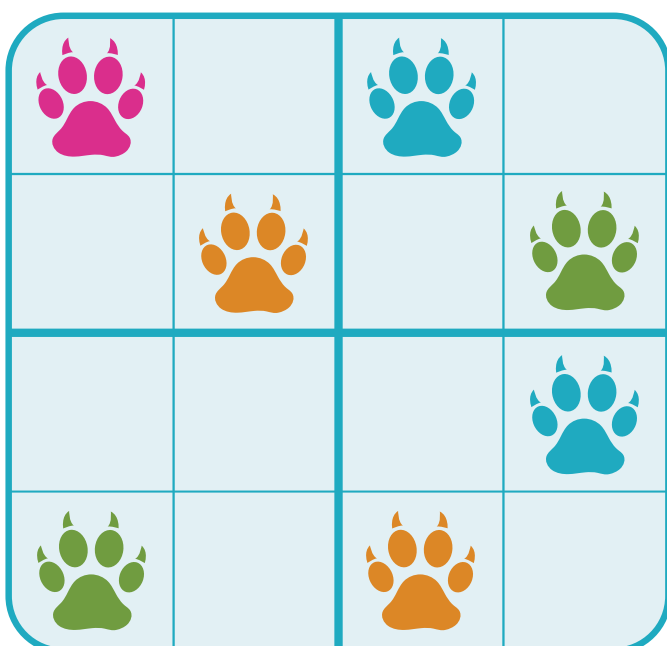

Paw Print Puzzle

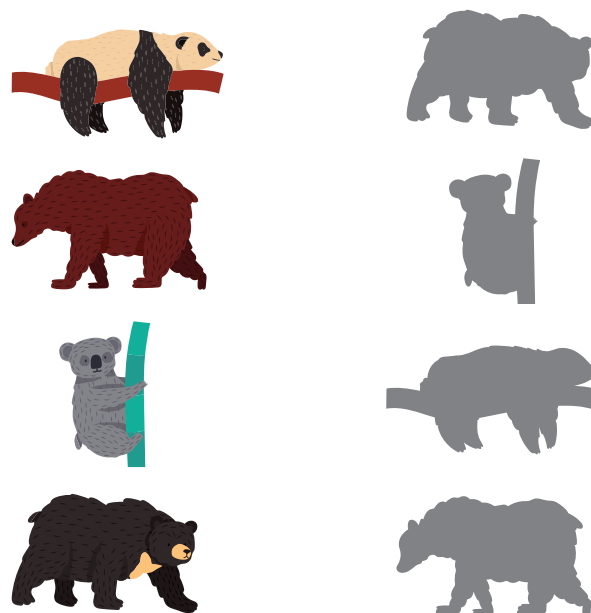
There should be one **blue** paw print, one **pink** paw print, one **orange** paw print and one **green** paw print in every row, column and 2x2 square.
